(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow telecoms works to be safely carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of The Length, St Nicholas at Wade, in the Thanet area.

An off-peak closure is planned for Tuesday 25 August 2020 between 09:30 hours and approximately 15:30 hours.

The Length will be closed in the general vicinity of the junction with Manor Road to the actual extent indicated on site

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A28 Canterbury Road and Manor Road.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – [BT Openreach Permit BC005CC8W00000WAQP6K8SA2], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
