Notice is hereby given that The KENT COUNTY COUNCIL acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under sections 1 and 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter called "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

The effect of the made named Order will introduce banned left-hand turn movements (including pedal cycles) in the following length of road in Thanet:-

ORCHARD CLOSE & PARISH CLOSE INTO MANOR ROAD

From Orchard Close & Parish Close (north east bound) into Manor Road, Birchington

The Order was made on 23 July 2020 and its provisions will come into effect on 27 July 2020.

A copy of the Order, statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, a map indicating the location and the effect and a copy of any Orders which will be amended by the Order may be examined on Monday to Friday at The Kent County Council, Sessions House, Maidstone, ME14 1XQ; The Kent County Council, Highway, Transportation & Waste, Ashford Highway Depot, Henwood Industrial Estate, Unit 4 Javelin Way, Ashford, Kent TN24 8AD during normal office hours or viewed online at www.kent.gov.uk/highwaysconsultations

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement to the Orders.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Section 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following order;

Commencement and Citation

- No person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle (including pedal cycles) to make a left-hand turn movement from Orchard Close and Parish Close (north east bound) into Manor Road, Birchington.
- Nothing in Article 1 shall apply to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes (in the event of an emergency), if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion.
- 3. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act.
- 4. The provisions of this order shall prevail over the provisions of any previous order.
- 5. This Order may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Manor Road, Birchington, The District of Thanet) (Prohibition of Left-Hand Turn Movements) Order 2019" ('this Order') and shall come into force on the 27 day of July 2020
